Conditions of Entry:

1. We are an **EFA affiliated school** and the competition will be run under EFA rules
2. **Horses are not to compete below their AFE grading points**
3. **Disclaimer statement** to be signed by the rider and the parent. **If the disclaimer is not signed your entry can not be accepted.**
4. One rider/horse – only the competitor to be mounted on the horse. More than one horse/rider but limit of 2 horses/class for dressage.
5. Horses may compete at two consecutive levels
6. Callers are permitted
7. Helmet – Aust Standard Safety Helmet AUS/NZ 38/38
8. Uniform – Jodhpurs, Riding boots, School shirt, Tie and Jumper. No blazers or jackets.
9. **NO DOGS**
10. **Entry form must be signed by parent. If not an EFA member your School Principal's signature is required + a Certificate of Currency for a student's Public Liability cover.**
11. A gear check is required between each class
12. There will be a limit of 25 entries per class. A class will only be held if sufficient numbers enter.
13. Open to Year 3 – 12 students.
